WORKSHOPS

An Introduction to Needle Felting – Bonnie Maggio

This is an opportunity to learn the basics and try out Needle Felting as a means of engaging groups in a natural craft which will facilitate the observation and study of natural woodland objects and animals. Needle Felting is a simple method of making 3 dimensional objects from wool by dry felting using special needles. Bonnie will take you through an introduction to the method and then you will be able to complete a small project of your own.

Make a kite from willow – Georgia Crook

Georgia will show how to make small and simple single stringed kites that actually fly from willow and tissue paper. You will also be able to experiment with other simple types of kite.
